Remembering Dr Janusz Grabowski

It was devastating to learn that Janusz is no more. His calm demeanor, smiling face and optimistic outlook was a source of great support in the projects we worked together.

I first met him in 1975, when he was a post doctorate fellow in the Chemical and Petroleum Engineering Department of the University of Calgary. I was very intrigued that he was educated and trained to become a nuclear scientist and, was very interested in the Eastern philosophies. Over the years, we worked together closely at Gulf Canada, Petroleum Recovery Institute, Alberta Research Council and, as consultants at Pengrowth, Tundra Oil & Gas and at YPF/Repsol (Argentina). We also taught a short (one week) course in Malaysia. I found him very focused, professional and dedicated.

Although he was adapting to his new home in Canada, he was strongly attached to Cracow and Poland. He was basically a scientist but also, very entrepreneurial. As a young man, he attended many sermons by the future Pope in Cracow and was always trying to understand the mysteries of life.
